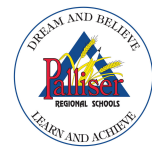

Student Code of Conduct Grade K-12

At Master's Academy & College we seek, through word and action, to create an environment of trust and mutual support in which each member of our community can grow. There is an emphasis on the need to be sensitive to those we come in contact with so that each student can realize their individual, God-given potential. As a staff we are committed to the on-going educational process of developing unique persons in a Christ-centred environment where faith is translated into action.

Mutual respect, cooperation and sharing are important values in any social experience. The ability to work individually, with and for others, are both important parts of the learning process. There must be respect for property, self and others, and the integration of Christian beliefs and values into the learning model.

Master's Academy & College has the responsibility to ensure that each student and staff member is provided with a safe and caring learning environment, respecting diversity and fostering a sense of belonging as mandated by the Alberta Government.

The prohibited grounds of discrimination are set out in the Alberta Human Rights Act.

Student behaviour, whether or not it occurs within the school building, during the school day or by electronic means must be acceptable in fostering the aforementioned safe and caring learning environment. Unacceptable behaviour is conduct that is injurious to the physical or mental well being of others in the school.

The consequences of unacceptable, inappropriate behaviour, taking into account the student's age, maturity and individual circumstances, will result in intervention and may result in suspension or termination of enrolment at Master's Academy & College.
